

Twin Corresponding Sudoku

Twin Corresponding Sudoku is a variation of the standard 9x9 Sudoku puzzle. It consists of two 9x9 grids that share the same numbers in the same positions. The first grid is a standard Sudoku puzzle, and the second grid is its twin. The twin is created by taking the first grid and replacing each number with its complement to 10 (e.g., 1 becomes 9, 2 becomes 8, etc.). This ensures that the sum of the numbers in any row, column, or 3x3 box is always 45.
